4.	Brief Description of Competition	Dance Baby Dance is a competition organized by the Organiser to search for young talent as dancers whereby the Winners will win cash prize upto RM1000.
5.	Brief mechanism of Competition	<ul> <li>Round 1: Preliminary (16<sup>th</sup> January 2023 – 29<sup>th</sup> January 2023)</li> <li>Contestants are required to upload a one (1) minute video of them dancing on Instagram with their full name, age and hashtag #RAAGADanceBaby in the caption.</li> <li>The song performed by the Contestants must be one of the songs listed on raaga.my.</li> <li>The video must not have any sort of filter or video effects.</li> <li>Contestants are required to keep their profile / account / post public during the Competition Period.</li> <li>Contestants can submit more than one (1) entry but only one (1) entry will be chosen for review by the Organiser.</li> <li>The contestants will be shortlisted under the categories below: Category A: 5 to 7 years old Category B: 8 to 10 years old</li> <li>Round 2: Grand Finale</li> <li>Five (5) shortlisted Contestants from each category, will be invited for a final round on 18th February 2023 at Mydin Subang Jaya Hypermarket, Persiaran Subang Permai, Taman Perindustrian USJ 1, 47500 Subang Jaya, Selangor.</li> <li>The Parents of the shortlisted Contestants will have to fill up a consent and indemnity form to be eligible to participate in the Grand Finale.</li> <li>The shortlisted Contestants will have to perform live in front of the panel of the judges.</li> <li>Any Contestants who fail to attend the finale event will be automatically eliminated.</li> <li>The three (3) Contestants from each category with the highest number of marks from the panel of judges will be announced as the Winners to win the cash prize.</li> </ul>
6.	Eligibility Criteria	a) The Competition is open to all Malaysians of the Age of Eligibility below.

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		b) Contestants must be Malaysian citizens and must possess valid Malaysian Identity Cards.
7.	Ineligibility	The following persons are not eligible to participate in the Competition :-
		(a) Employees/vendors/contractors and their *immediate family members of the Organiser, MEASAT Broadcast Network Systems Sdn Bhd, Astro Entertainment Sdn Bhd, Astro Production Sdn Bhd, Astro Digital 5 Sdn Bhd and Astro Malaysia Holdings Berhad, the sponsor of the Competition and their affiliates and partners.
		(b) Has won any prize(s) up to a value either individually or collectively of a value of RM1,000 and below from the Radio Station in the period of thirty (30) days prior to entering the Competition.
		(c) Has won any prize(s) up to a value either individually or collectively of a value of RM1,001 to RM5,000 from the Radio Station in the period of ninety (90) days prior to entering the Competition.
		(d) Has won any prize(s) up to a value either individually or collectively of a value of RM5,001 and above from the Radio Station in the period of three hundred and sixty-five (365) days prior to entering the Competition.
		*immediate family members mean spouse, children, parents, brothers and sisters
8.	Age of Eligibility	a) The Contest is open to all Malaysians who are 5 years old to 10 years old at the time of submission of entry or as at the first date of the Competition Period.
		b) Where the Age of Eligibility permits participation of Contestants under the age of 18 years old, the Contestant must obtain the consent of his/her parent or legal guardian in order to be eligible to participate in the Competition and to receive the Prize. The Organiser considers it the responsibility of parents and/or guardian to monitor their children's participation in this Competition. The parents and/or guardian may at the absolute discretion of the Organiser be required to sign an indemnity in the form required by the Organiser as a precondition to their child's entitlement to the Prize.

		The Organiser shall be entitled to request to sight the original Identity Card or the originals of other supporting documents/materials for verification purposes.
12.	Entry Deadline	Entries must be received by the Organiser on or before 11.59pm on 29 <sup>th</sup> January 2023.
		Entries received before the commencement of the Competition Period and after the stipulated Entry Deadline will be disqualified and ineligible for consideration for participation and/or prizes.
